

# WHEW! I've Registered! Now What Happens?



## When will I hear from the Team Coach?

Coaches will receive team rosters with your child's name and your contact information by February 23<sup>rd</sup>. If you have not been contacted by **March 3<sup>rd</sup>**, please email [coachadmin@ayso208.org](mailto:coachadmin@ayso208.org) and we will get you in touch with your child's coach.

## How Often Are Practices and Games?

Practice frequency, times and locations are up to the coach. In general, the younger age groups will practice once a week while the older age groups may practice more often. Games are held on Saturdays at our complex at 17<sup>th</sup> and Ridge Road with the first game beginning **March 22<sup>nd</sup>**. Players in the 10U and older divisions may travel to other AYSO Regions around Wichita for inter-regional play on Saturdays throughout the season.

## What Else Does My Child Need?

The registration fee includes a complete uniform including a jersey, shorts, and socks. The uniform will be handed out by the coach prior to the first games.

Players may play in tennis shoes; however, you may want to purchase soccer shoes (without a toe cleat).

Each player should also have a water bottle and a soccer ball

- 8U & younger - size 3
- 10U & 12U - size 4
- 15U & older - size 5

## What About Refunds?

Players who withdraw before their first practice and who have not been issued a uniform may request a full refund by emailing [treasurer208@ayso208.org](mailto:treasurer208@ayso208.org) prior to the start of games. No refunds will be issued after the start of games, unless there are extenuating circumstances.
