When will I hear from the Team Coach?

Coaches will receive team rosters with your child's name and your contact information by February 23rd. If you have not been contacted by **March 3rd**, please email coachadmin@ayso208.org and we will get you in touch with your child's coach.

How Often Are Practices and Games?

Practice frequency, times and locations are up to the coach. In general, the younger age groups will practice once a week while the older age groups may practice more often. Games are held on Saturdays at our complex at 17th and Ridge Road with the first game beginning **March 22nd**.
